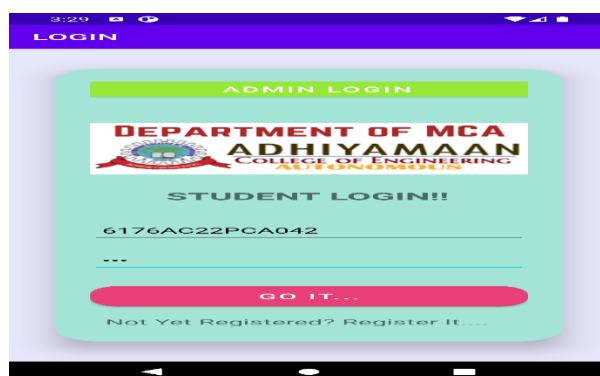
MYSQL
